BUS BOOST FOR BOX HILL

Bus customers will benefit from improvements to the route 746 service in Box Hill, with changes to the route and 85 additional weekly services added to the timetable from 3 June.

Member for Castle Hill Ray Williams MP said "The NSW Government is committed to delivering improvements to public transport services where and when they are needed".

"Box Hill is a growing suburb in Sydney's North West which is why we are converting the current route 746 loop service to an extended route to meet the growing needs of residents moving into this area.

"The change will mean direct services between Riverstone, Box Hill and the Rouse Hill Town Centre for customers, while the extra services will mean more regular services on weekdays.

"We'll continue to consider further enhancements to services in the Box Hill area as new roads are built and more customers move into the suburb."

Customers will also benefit from 40 additional services each week on route 608 between Windsor and Rouse Hill, with more services earlier in the day for customers travelling towards Windsor, and extra services in the afternoon for those travelling back to Rouse Hill.

To reduce duplication on the network, route 600 between West Pennant Hills, Cherrybrook and Parramatta, and route 631 between Castle Hill and Pennant Hills, will be discontinued from 3 June, with alternative services available.

These routes currently operate a limited number of services on weekdays, with Route 631 being converted to school bus services.

Customers who use the 631 will still be able to travel between Castle Hill and Pennant Hills on routes 625, 626, 632, 633 and M60, and customers using route 600 can use routes 621 and M60.

There will also been changes to routes T60, T61, T62, T63, T64, T65 and T66. From 3 June, all of these services will terminate at Parramatta Interchange with frequent services to Prince Alfred Park available on routes M60, 601, 603, 604, 606, 609 and 706.

There will also be minor timetable changes to most Hillsbus services operated in Western Sydney and customers are advised to plan their journey at www.transportnsw.info.
