FUNDING ANNOUNCED - 2017 COMMUNITY BUILDING PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

The electorate of Castle Hill has secured grant funding of \$300,000 for a total of 12 projects as part of the NSW Government's 2017 Community Building Partnership (CBP) program.

The NSW Government has committed funds to new community infrastructure projects that will enhance much needed local facilities.

The Local Member for Castle Hill Ray Williams said he was pleased to receive this State Government funding. The funding will aim to create more vibrant and inclusive communities and deliver positive social, environmental and recreational outcomes. Some of the key projects which successfully obtained a grant include:
