FUNDING BOOST FOR RESERVE TRUSTS IN CASTLE HILL

Member for Castle Hill Ray Williams announced the NSW Government will contribute 36,392 towards the management of public reserves in the Caste Hill region.

The funding is part of the NSW Government's 2017-18 Public Reserves Management Fund program.

Mr Williams said the Public Reserves Management Fund provides financial support to maintain the community's highly-valued public assets.

"State-owned public reserves play an important role in our communities and the NSW Government is committed to ensuring these reserves continue to provide social and economic benefits to the people of NSW," Mr Williams said.

"This funding will directly benefit our community, boost our economy and contribute to the cultural, sporting and recreational life of our region."

Across the state, 440 projects will benefit from \$15 million in the latest round of the Public Reserves Management Fund. In our electorate the Holland Road Reserve was the selected successful project that will be funded in 2017-18.

\$94 million has been invested over the last six years in the upgrade of grounds, the repair of buildings, bushfire hazard reduction, weed control and building new infrastructure.

The NSW Government is committed to ensuring this state owned reserve continue to provide benefits to the people of Castle Hill and contribute to the cultural, sporting and recreational life of our region.
