LOCAL STUDENT AWARDED PRESTIGIOUS SCHOLARSHIP

Lauren Adler of Castle Hill was one of fifteen university students to have been awarded the annual 2017 Horizon Scholarship.

This scholarship is an initiative of the Rural Industries Research and Development Corporation (RIRDC) in partnership with leading industry sponsors, which recognises leadership and commitment to the future of Australian agriculture.

The successful scholars were selected from a talent pool of more than 150 applicants nationwide are ones to watch when it comes to shaping the future of Australian agriculture.

Lauren studied agriculture and Primary Industries at Oak Hill High School, where she made the NSW Education Standard Distinguished Achievements List; and has now commenced her first year studying Rural Science at Armidale University.
