NSW GOVERNMENT FUNDS CASTLE HILL WALKING AND CYCLING PROJECTS

Member for Castle Hill Ray Williams has announced that pedestrians and cyclists in Castle Hill will benefit from an extra \$850,000 in funding for walkways and shared paths in the state budget.

The extra funds will build:

- Two new pedestrian refuges on Windsor Road, Kellyville
- 2.9km of shared path along Windsor Road, Kellyville.

Mr Williams said the investment would make it easier than ever to get around.

"Projects like these will make a real difference to those who live and work in our community," Mr Williams said.

This funding is in addition to a massive \$80 million investment in the Cycling Infrastructure Fund.

The NSW Government has been listening to key groups in the community, like Bicycle NSW and Bicycle Networks to prioritise, plan and extend paths all over New South Wales.

Mr Williams stated "This investment on active transport infrastructure is unprecedented, as we are determined to make it easier for people who walk or ride to work to do so more safely".
