LOCALS TO HELP DESIGN NEW BEAUMONT HILLS PARK

The local community will be able to help shape the design of a new \$4 million park as part of a \$50 million program to upgrade and create new parks in Greater Sydney.

Member for Castle Hill Ray Williams MP said Kellyville and Beaumont Hills communities will be able to provide input on the new park which will eventually form part of the proposed Caddies Creek Sports Complex.

"The community has a unique opportunity to create a green space to suit their growing needs and there's no better place to provide a central park than in the centre of a new housing area that is close to the Sydney Metro skytrain," Mr Mr Williams said.

"This site has a rich history as the ancient homeland of the Bidjigal people but also includes the ruins the 19th century pub, The White Hart Inn, which was found by archeologists during construction of the Metro skytrain."

Minister for Planning and Public Spaces Rob Stokes said the new park in Beaumont Hills is one of eight parks being funded.

"The Parks for People program recognises how valuable our green, open spaces are to everyone," Mr Stokes said.

"It's become clear during the pandemic that our parks are vital to protect and maintain our social, physical and emotional well-being."

The new Beaumont Hills park supports the Greener Public Spaces Premier's Priority to increase the proportion of homes in urban areas within 10 minutes' walk of quality green, open and public space by 10 per cent by 2023.
