SAFETY FIRST WITH NEW SCHOOL ZONE AT BOX HILL

Safety will come first for students attending the new Santa Sophia Catholic College at Box Hill with a school zone to be installed next month.

Member for Castle Hill Ray Williams MP said Transport for NSW was committed to providing safe travel for the new school community from when gates first open on Tuesday 5 October.

“The new school zone will surround the campus along Fontana Drive, Red Gables Road and Lakefront Crescent as well as a small section of Cataract Crescent,” Mr Williams said.

“The speed limit will be 40 km/h between 7.30am and 9.30am and from 2pm to 4pm on school days, and the community is asked to please note these periods extend beyond the standard school zone timeframes.”

Signs will advise motorists of the changed traffic conditions and motorists are reminded the 40 km/h limit will be in place from Tuesday 5 October, even though stay-at-home orders remain in place.

Members of the community can sign up at the Safer Roads NSW website to receive updates about changes to permanent speed limits in their nominated area and to have a say on speed limits.

SCHOOL ZONE DETAILS: The section on Fontana Drive will run from 240 metres south of Red Gables Road to the cul-de-sac north of Lakefront Crescent, a distance of about 580 metres. The section on Red Gables Road will run from 100 metres west of Fontana Drive to 20 metres east of Cataract Road, a distance of about 365 metres. The section on Cataract Road will run from 10 metres south of Red Gables Road. Lakefront Crescent will be covered by the school zone speed limit in its entirety.
