COMMUNITIES IN CASTLE HILL TO HAVE THEIR SAY ON LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE

A re-elected NSW Liberal and Nationals Government will ensure people in Castle Hill have a greater say on where and how local developer contributions are spent in their local community.

Under the plan, the Government will work with councils to allow people to provide feedback via Service NSW on how local contributions are spent and the types of community infrastructure to be built such as new parks and sports facilities. Long-term critical growth and maintenance infrastructure would not be impacted by the proposal.
