Fantastic news for families across Castle Hill as they are set to benefit from the NSW Government's landmark \$1.3 billion Affordable Preschool Program.

The program aims to ensure children across NSW have access to high quality preschool education, whilst also lowering the cost of living for families.

Annual savings include up to \$4,220 per 3-5 year-old child in a community/mobile preschool and up to \$2,110 for each 4-5 year-old child in an eligible preschool program in long day care, on top of their Child Care Subsidy.

\$29 MILLION FOR SPORT FACILITIES INCLUDING BASKETBALL & NETBALL MEGA CENTRE



The NSW Government has allocated \$29 million through WestInvest for local sport facilities, including the \$15 million refurbishment of Horseworld Stadium in Maraylya.

This project will convert the existing equestrian centre into a huge recreational facility offering basketball and a range of indoor short course sports.
