It was my great pleasure to present Jenny Walker of Kellyville Public School the 2023 Local Woman of the Year Award.

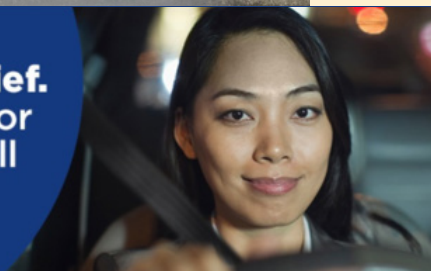

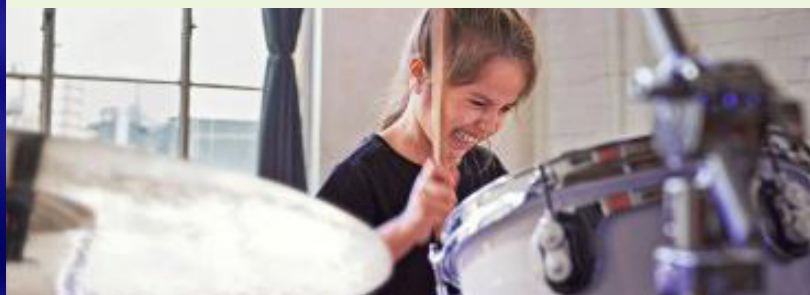

* CHANGES TO THE STATE ELECTORATE

To ensure the number of electors within each district remains approximately the same, a redistribution takes place after every second New South Wales State general election.

The recent distribution has resulted in a large portion of the current Castle Hill Electorate coming under the new name of “Kellyville”.

The new Kellyville Electorate will include the suburbs of Baulkham Hills, Beaumont Hills, Bella Vista, Castle Hill, Kellyville, Norwest, North Kellyville and Rouse Hill.

The new boundaries will be in place for the NSW State election on 25 March 2023. This means that you may be voting for a new electoral district, even if your address has not changed.

Learning to swim is the only sport that can save your child’s life. Being able to swim is an essential life-saving skill because drowning is still one of the most common causes of accidental death in children.

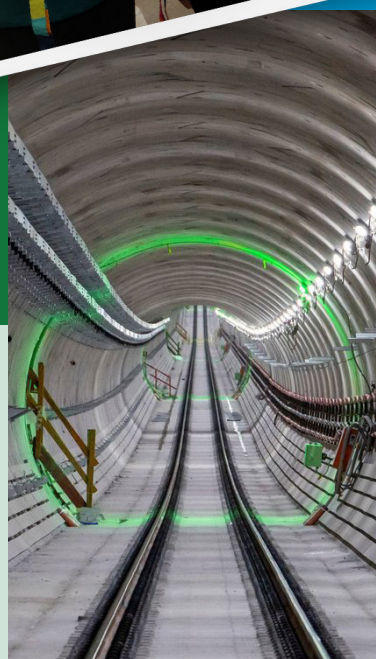
